

**February 1, 2010**

The Straban Township Board of Supervisors met this day, February 1, 2010, 7:00 p.m. at 1745 Granite Station Road, Gettysburg.

The Supervisors, Wally Davis and the Zoning Officer will be meeting on February 4, 2010 to discuss zoning issues.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Skip Strayer was concerned about the Resolution to endorse Journey through Hallowed Ground.

Sharon Hamm stated this is a tree planting effort. They want to plant a tree for each citizen who sacrificed their life in the Civil War. The trees will appear as soldiers in formation from Monticello to Gettysburg. The property owner does not pay for the trees or maintains them. Property owners do not have to do this if they don't want to.

- Postcards were sent to residents located in Sewer District 1 as a reminder and letters were sent out to Sewer District 2 residents that they will need to pump their systems.

- The planning Commission reviewed the revised SALDO. There were some questions on Traffic and a definition.
- A truck ran over a lamp post in the Commerce Park. ACEDC called us to say we owned them. The Park's Protective Covenants says they are required to maintain the lights.

Troy Martin moved to instruct Wally Davis to send a letter to ACEDC stating that the township does not own the lights, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Spangler, motion carried.

Mike Spangler moved to grant the Historic Preserves an extension until September 13, 2010, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Troy Martin, motion carried.

Sharon Hamm gave a copy of a letter to Crissy Redding-Myers from a resident that was very appreciative of her.

Joey Byrne (United Hook & Ladder) stated there were 31 calls in January. Our Appreciation Banquet will be held on March 6, 2010.

**February 1, 2010**

Skip Strayer explained that in the past a street light was requested at the Hoffman Road/Route 116 intersection. At the time, they were waiting for poles to be replaced, which have now been replaced, so the streetlight can now be put up.

The Board took the request under advisement.

Skip Strayer stated in regards to the McDonald's Sketch Plan, when Waybrant's subdivided there were a lot of meetings on issues with their right-of-way in front. They could have the parking spaces in front with the understanding that if Route 30 is ever widened they would lose those parking spaces.
