The Straban Township Planning Commission did not meet this date, as publicly advertised. A novel coronavirus (now known as “COVID-19”) emerged in Wuhan, China, began infecting humans in November 2019, and has since spread throughout the world, including the United States. On March 6, 2020, pursuant to Section 7301(c) of the Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101, et seq., Governor Tom Wolf issued a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency, proclaiming the existence of a disaster emergency across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a result of the spread of coronavirus or COVID-19. On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the COVID-19 virus a pandemic. The Board of Supervisors of the Township issued a Declaration of Disaster Emergency on March 17, 2020, recognizing the existence of a disaster emergency in the Township due to the COVID-19.

The Planning Commission members decided it was best to cancel this meeting.
