**WELL RESTRICTION AREA:**

\_\_\_\_ EPA will be notified of any new well permits submitted to Straban Township in the Well Restriction Area as defined on Figure 1 and Figure 2;

\_\_\_\_ EPA will review the proposed well location to determine if the well is likely to be impacted by groundwater contamination from the Site; and

\_\_\_\_ EPA will recommend that Straban Township approve or disapprove of the proposed well location or recommend an alternate well location that is unlikely to be impacted by groundwater contamination from the Site.



**SITE BACKGROUND FOR SHRIVER'S CORNER ROAD:**

The Site consists of two areas, the Culp Area and the Shealer Area, located along Shriver's Corner Road and Culp Road, in Straban Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania (Figure 1). Due to disposal practices groundwater was contaminated with volatile organic compounds (VOCs). There are two plumes of groundwater contamination, one from each property. The contaminated groundwater is located within the contaminated fractures in the bedrock and the main VOC contaminants are trichloroethene, 1,1,1-trichloroethane, and 1,1-dichloroethene.

**SITE BACKGROUND FOR HUNTERSTOWN ROAD:**

The Site is located east and west of Hunterstown Road located about 1.5 miles northeast of downtown Gettysburg in Straban Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania (Figure 2). Due to disposal practices on two parcels, known as the Shealer properties, groundwater was contaminated with volatile organic compounds (VOCs). There are two plumes of groundwater contamination. The contaminated groundwater is located within the contaminated fractures in the bedrock and the main VOC contaminants are trichloroethene, cis-1,2-dichloroethene, 1,1,1-trichloroethane, and 1,1-dichloroethene.



A complete and full copy of the Well Ordinance will be needed by the well driller so all regulations are complied with.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUPERVISION AND REGULATION OF ALL WELLS OR BOREHOLES WHICH MAY BE CONSTRUCTED FOR OBTAINING OR ACCESSING WATER FOR DOMESTIC AND OTHER PURPOSES IN STRABAN TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

### **SECTION 8. DUTIES OF THE PROPERTY OWNER**

The Owner of the property on which a well for domestic water geothermal wells and geothermal boreholes) use is to be utilized shall:

1. Apply to the Township for a well permit, providing, on the prescribed form: name and address of applicant, name and address of land owner where well is to be drilled, name and address and license number of well driller, site location and address, and proposed date for drilling to begin. A site plan (sketch) showing location of existing or proposed buildings, driveways, septic systems within isolation distance as required by DEP, including adjoining properties, and other wells must be attached to the application.
2. Have all wells constructed by a qualified Pennsylvania licensed well driller to meet, at a minimum, the rules and regulations of this ordinance and any administrative agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
3. Submit any relevant information or data concerning the constructed well to the Township, including a signed Well Construction Completion Report (please see Section 10.21) and a copy of well water test results obtained from the well driller, **prior to issuance of a Land Use Permit.**
